in Class 46, Foods and ingredients of foods.

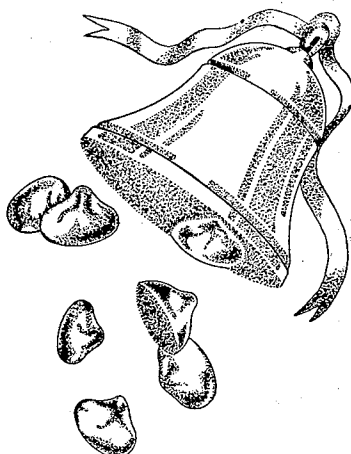
The trade-mark has been in use since January, 1913.
