STATEMENT.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that THE DÉ LEON BANDEAU Co., a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri, having a regular and established place of business at 321 North Fourteenth street and 2115 Locust street, St. Louis, Missouri, has adopted the trade-mark shown in the accompanying drawing, for hat-bandeaux, Class No. 40, Fancy goods, furnishings, and notions.

The trade-mark has been continuously used in the business of said corporation and the firm of the Dé Leon Bandeau Co., its predecessor from whom it derived title, since about the first day of September, 1914.

The trade-mark is applied to the goods by means of cloth labels on which the trade-mark appears.
