STATEMENT.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that THE STEARNS & FOSTER COMPANY, a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of Ohio, and located and doing business in the village of Lockland, in the county of Hamilton and State of Ohio, has adopted and used the trade-mark shown in the accompanying drawing, for cotton-battling, particularly glazed-cotton wadding, in Class No. 1, Raw or partly-prepared materials.

The trade-mark has been continuously used in the business of said corporation since November 1st, 1899.

The trade-mark is applied by imprinting the same on the wrappers of the article and by stenciling the same on the bales and packages containing the goods.
