To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that LIMPERT BROS., INC., a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of New York, and located in the city of New York, borough of Manhattan, in the county and State of New York, and doing business at 625 Greenwich Street, in said city and borough, has adopted and used the trade-mark shown in the accompanying drawing, consisting of the word "Cherri-Bon," for a nonalcoholic, maltless beverage flavored
