STATEMENT.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ISABELLE MCKEE BLOCH, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Seattle, King county, State of Washington, and doing business at No. 501 Montelius Music Building, in said city, have adopted and used the trade-mark shown in the accompanying drawing, for piano-player rolls, in Class 36, Musical instruments and supplies.

The trade-mark has been continuously used in my business since August 14th, 1919.

The trade-mark is applied or affixed to the goods, or to the packages containing the same, by placing thereon a printed label on which the trade-mark is shown.

The words "Trade Mark," "Player Rolls," "Reg. U. S. Pat. Off." and also the representation of the goods form no part of the mark and are hereby disclaimed.
