STATEMENT.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that Ajax Iron Works, a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of Pennsylvania, with principal office in the city of Corry, county of Erie, in said State, has adopted and used the trade mark shown in the accompanying drawing, for drilling engines, engine pumps and parts used in the oil industry, in Class 23, Cutlery, machinery, and tools, and parts thereof.

No claim is made to the word "Engines" apart from the trade-mark as shown by the drawing.

The trade mark has been continuously used in the business of said corporation since 1892.

The mark is applied to the goods, or packages or cartons containing the same by affixing thereto a printed label on which the trademark is shown, or by molding, stamping or painting the trademark directly upon the goods.
