STATEMENT

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that Societe Anonyme des Anciens Etablissements Panhard & Lavassor, a corporation duly organized under the laws of the Republic of France, located in the city of Paris, France, and doing business at 19, Avenue d'Ivry, in said city, has adopted for its use the trade-mark shown in the accompanying drawing.

The trade-mark has been continuously used in its business since April 1, 1909.

The particular description of goods to which the trade-mark is appropriated is TRACTORS AND INTERNAL COMBUSTION ENGINES, comprised in Class 23, Cutlery, machinery, and tools, and parts thereof, applicant being the owner of registration No. 82267, dated June 8, 1911.

The trade-mark is usually displayed by printing same on labels which are attached to packages containing the goods.

Said trade-mark has been registered in France dated April 26, 1923 No. 217199. Mock & Blum, whose postal address is 10 East 40th Street, New York, N. Y., are designated, as applicant's representative, on whom process or notice of proceedings affecting the right of ownership of said trade-mark brought under the laws of the United States may be served.
